Dr. Reighard has been a Professor of Piano and Fine Arts at Southern Nazarene University since 1969. He earned a Bachelor of Music degree SNU and holds both a Master and Doctorate of Musical Arts degrees from the University of Oklahoma. Dr. Reighard is a retired professor of piano, music theory and Fine Arts at SNU. He taught there for 48 years before retiring in 2017. When at SNU, he was given the Excellence in Teaching award from the students five times, and has been honored with SNU Outstanding Alumni award. In 1999 he was honored as one of 100 distinguished alumni representatives for the centennial celebration of SNU.



His tenure for the past twenty-five years as church pianist and organist has been with several of Oklahoma City's largest churches and he currently serves as organist at OKC First Church of the Nazarene.

As a pianist, Dr. Reighard has performed for audiences locally and also throughout the US and internationally. His piano repertoire includes classical compositions, popular music improvisations and arrangements of contemporary and traditional church music selections.

He has been blessed with so many alumni friends including the pastoral teams of Johnson, Vera (both George and Chris) and Stringer and many others in the congregation.
